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On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, executive session was entered into at 9:00 a.m. to discuss personnel matters and exited at 10:47 a.m.

Ted Priest, Chief Zoning Official, was present for the site plan review application of Urbancrest Baptist Church in Turtlecreek Township.

Mr. Priest reviewed all comments, concerns and recommendations from all department and officials concerned. He then stated the recommendation to approve the site plan review application subject to certain conditions.

The Board stated a concern relative to needed road improvements on Drake Road.

Mr. and Mrs. Lutmer, adjacent property owners, stated a concern relative to drainage from parking lots and discharge of the sewage system.

Commissioner Kilburn explained that a church is permitted in any zone and the responsibility of this Board is to ensure criteria is met to help elevate concerns of adjacent property owners.

The Board discussed the possibility of a 100-foot turn lane being an additional requirement by the County Engineer.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #01-1867) to approve the site plan review application subject to two conditions.

Karen Garrett, Economic Development, was present to discuss the proposed amendment to the Community Reinvestment Area #2 in Hamilton Township, Warren County, Ohio.

Mr. Rippe, developer desiring to relocate in the area, explained the proposal to relocate four existing locations to one central location consisting of approximately 212 employees and \$12 million investment.

Upon further discussion, the Board approved the amendment to the Community Reinvestment Area #2 for the 66.52 acres proposed for development at this time.
