Doug McNeil, Middletown Regional Hospital, was present along with Jim VanDeGriff and Dan Jones, Turtlecreek Township Trustees, for a work session relative to the relocation of Middletown Regional Hospital in Turtlecreek Township.

Mr. McNeil explained the concept plan for the proposed new development on Greentree Road and stated the reasons behind their decision to relocate to this location rather that State Route 122 location.

There was much discussion relative to the Board's desire to have the hospital relocation at State Route 122/ Interstate 75 interchange and how many millions of dollars in improvements would be saved by moving to said location.

Bob Gray and Bobby Jay, Warren County residents, all spoke in opposition to the relocation to Greentree Road area.

David McGatten, Mason resident, stated that he works for Middletown and is in favor of the relocation to Greentree Road.

Upon further discussion, Mr. McNeil stated the hospital's intent to relocation on Greentree Road in Turtlecreek Township.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
