DISCUSSIONS

Commissioner Kilburn entered the meeting at 10:17 a.m.

On motion, bids were closed at 10:15 a.m. this 5th day of March, 2002, and the following bids were received, opened and read aloud for 2002 Dump Trailer for the Warren County Engineer:

Neil Tunison, Warren County Engineer will review bids for a recommendation at a later date.

Mrs. Shutts, resident of Turtlecreek Township, was present to request the Board to enact a "master plan" for development in her area.

The Board informed her of the Land Use Plan on file in the Regional Planning Commission and directed her to contact Mr. Craig, Director.

Marilee Swarzwalder and Karin Haeberlin, Humane Association, were present to request additional funds from the Board for the Spay and Neuter program.

Mrs. Swarzwalder stated their request to increase their annual allocation from \$5000 to \$7500.

Upon discussion, the Board agreed to the additional funding.

PUBLIC HEARING

ANNEXATION PETITION OF WILLIAM DETERS II TO ANNEX 90.5793 ACRES TO THE CITY OF LEBANON

The public hearing to consider the annexation petition of William Deters II, agent to annex 90.5793 acres to the City of Lebanon was reconvened this 5th day of March 2002, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

William Deters, II, Agent stated that the property is owned by the Lebanon City School District and the City of Lebanon. He stated the school's desire to construct a new high school on the property. He then stated that all matters required by law have been complied with.

Commissioner Kilburn questioned if the property is considered contiguous to the City of Lebanon due to the "ball on a string" decision of the Court of Appeals.

Mr. Deters stated that it meets the test due to it being city owned property and not road right-ofway.

Commissioner Kilburn questioned Rachel Hutzel, Assistant County Prosecutor, her opinion on the matter.

Ms. Hutzel stated her desire to see case law prior to making a recommendation to the Board.

Mr. Deters stated the need for annexation is essential for construction of the new school.

Mrs. Lutmer, adjacent property owner, questioned if the utilities will be connected through the railroad property or along Drake Road.

Pat Clements, City of Lebanon, stated that the only planned use of the railroad right-of-way is to provide electric services to the property. He stated that water and sanitary sewer will come from the southwest entrance of Drive Road, behind the Harmon property and Country Creek Subdivision.

Bob Singlebrock, adjacent property owner, stated his concern relative to electric going in behind his property.

There was much discussion relative to how utilities would reach the proposed development and the lack of notification of the time and place of the public hearing to adjacent property owners.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board stated their desire to mandate the Agent for Petitioners to notify all adjacent property owners of the time and date of hearings or the Board will not conduct proceedings.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #02-390) to continue the public hearing to April 25, 2002, at 6:15 p.m.

Dan Druffles, 8643 Morrow-Cozaddale Road, was present along with Jerry Spurling, Chief Building Official, to discuss requirements being mandated by the Building Department when he was originally told the building construction was exempt due to agricultural use.

Upon discussion, the Board worked out a compromise for Mr. Druffles on the list of items Mr. Druffles presented.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, Beth Deckard, County Recorder, and Gary Browning, Data Processing Director, were present to escort the Board to view the large document scanner on loan in the Map Room for possible purchase. The Board convened to the Map Room and upon return, stated their agreement to purchase the equipment.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
