ANNEXATION PETITION OF 3.722 ACRES TO THE CITY OF LEBANON ALAN ABES, AGENT

The public hearing to consider the annexation petition of Alan Abes, Agent to annex 3.722 acres to the City of Lebanon was convened this 4th day of June 2002, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Mr. Abes stated that the petition includes roadway constructed by the City of Lebanon and deletes a previous island. He then presented documentation that all legal requirement have been complied with and requested the Board to approve the annexation petition.

ANNEXATION PETITION OF ALAN ABES, AGENT TO ANNEX 3.294 ACRES TO THE CITY OF LEBANON

The public hearing to consider the annexation petition of Alan Abes, Agent to annex 3.294 acres to the City of Lebanon was convened this 4th day of June 2002, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Alan Abes, agent for petitioners, stated the area includes two city owned lots needed to construct and extend the proposed bike path.

Scott Brunka, City Engineer, stated the purpose for annexing the road right of way is to connect the two lots together to continue the bike trail.

Don Brosius, attorney for Turtlecreek Township, presented testimony and evidence in opposition to the annexation.

There was much discussion relative to the number of valid owners and if the Board could legally proceed with the public hearing.

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Dan Jones, Township Trustees, stated his opinion that the property is not contiguous to Lebanon or the general good of the territory will be met if approved.

There was discussion relative to adequate service has been provided as an error in the newspaper was brought to the attention of the Board.

William Stevens, Turtlecreek Township Fire Chief, stated his desire to ensure the fire department does not lose the access road into the adjacent subdivision if the annexation is approved.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #02-871) to continue the public hearing to July 25, 2002, at 5:30 p.m.

ANNEXATION PETITION OF CLYDE LAMB, AGENT TO ANNEX 51.587 ACRES TO THE VILLAGE OF HARVEYSBURG
