PUBLIC HEARING

SERVICES CHANGES TO THE WARREN COUNTY TRANSIT SYSTEM

Jerry Haddix, Grants Coordinator, was present this 11th day of June 2002, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room for the public hearing to consider service changes to the Warren County Transit System.

Mr. Haddix stated the purpose of the public hearing is to consider the elimination of the Dayton route from the Warren County Transit System. He stated that the cost of the route is \$8.50 per person but cost the system \$75,000 per year and recommends this route be eliminated.

Earl Alexander, driver of the route, stated that when he isn't driving people to Dayton, he is servicing "same day" calls within the County.

Commissioner Kilburn stated his desire to ensure efficiency in managing the transit system so that they get the most service out of the least amount of money.

A representative of Universal Transportation stated the need for coordinated services relative to transportation so not to have duplicative services.

Commissioner South stated her desire to continue the public hearing to allow additional time to analyze the future of the transit service.

Upon further discussion, the Board continued the public hearing to July 16, 2002, at 10:30 a.m.

Barry Sullivan, Zoning Inspector, was present for the site plan review application of Mason Community Church in Union Township.

Mr. Sullivan stated the church's desire to convert the existing pole barn into a church. He stated the review comments from all departments and officials concerned and reviewed the recommendation from the County Engineer relative to drainage. He then stated the EPA approval subject to three conditions.

Robert Ware, Regional Planning Commission, questioned the number of signs proposed.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #02-909) to approve the site plan review application subject to three (3) conditions.

Ken Haley, Lebanon Conservancy Group, was present to request the Board's to sponsor the tour busses for the Home and Garden Tour.

The Board stated their opinion that County tax dollars shouldn't be spent for this kind of private project.
