## DISCUSSIONS

Members of the Lebanon City Council were present along with many concerned citizens for a work session to discuss the proposed video lottery terminals (VLT's) being proposed by the Ohio General Assembly at the racetracks within the State of Ohio.

Commissioner Kilburn reviewed the situation at the Warren County Fairgrounds and stated his opposition to gambling in Warren County.

Amy Brewer, Mayor of Lebanon, stated that she along with the City Council members were present in order to gather information. She stated that they do not have enough information to make a decision relative to being in favor of or in opposition to VLT's. She also stated several questions that need answered before they can make an informed opinion.

Norm Dryer, City Council member, stated his desire to not rush into a yes or no vote. He stated his desire to obtain additional information.

Jim Norris, Council member, questioned how to get the answers to the questions in order to make a decision on this issue.

Lori Morgan, Ken Blackwell's Office, was present and spoke in opposition to the VLT's.

Gil Garrard was present and questioned what the racetrack has done for Lebanon. He stated he hasn't seen anything good come from it period. He then stated his opinion that the City does not need additional gambling at the Lebanon Raceway.

Pastor John Cooper along with several area ministers questioned if the area residents were willing to sell their souls for money and spoke in opposition to additional gambling within Warren County.

A representative from the Ohio Horseman's Association was present and spoke in favor of the proposed legislation along with Jerry Quillen, President of the Lebanon Raceway Employees Association.

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Upon further discussion, the majority of the Board stated their desire to obtain additional information in order to make an informed decision.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
