## **DISCUSSIONS**

Doris Bishop, Human Services Director, was present to explain the need for a contract with Lifespan, Inc. to provide money management skills to participants in the "Jobs Club".

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Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #03-1044) to approve and enter into contract with Lifespan, Inc.

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On motion, bids were closed at 10:15 a.m. this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July and the following bids were received, opened and read aloud for FY 2002 Village of Maineville Sidewalk Project for the Warren County Office of Grants Administration:

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Commissioner Kilburn discussed the need for a traffic signal at State Route 48 and Foster Maineville Road in Hamilton Township.

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Sheriff Ariss was present to explain the Dare Grant and the effectiveness of the grant. Sheriff Ariss stated the results of a survey from teachers and administrators requesting the continuation of the program.

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Sheriff Ariss then stated his opinion that the Dare program is a good program and requested the Board to continue it.

Upon discussion, the Board signed the grant award for the Dare Grant.

PUBLIC HEARING #2 CONTINUATION

## AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DESIGN OF STORM SEWER AND STORM WATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

The continuation of Public Hearing #2 to consider amendments to the rules and regulations for the design of storm sewer and stormwater management systems was convened this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July 2003, in the Commissioners Meeting Room.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, presented copies of the changes as suggested by Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, after his review of the proposed amendments.

Commissioner Kilburn questioned what the major changes are in the amended regulations.

Mr. Tunison stated that they will create a detailed record plan and therefore good records of what is in place if stormwater management districts are created.

Commissioner Kilburn then questioned if the engineering companies supplying these record plans are bonded if the system fails.

Mr. Tunison stated they all have liability insurance.

The Board then questioned Dave McElroy, Soil & Water Management District, if he was in favor of the proposed changes.

Mr. McElroy stated his desire for the Board to adopt the amendments to the regulations.

Upon further discussion, the Board closed the public hearing and resolved (Resolution #03-1057) to adopt the new rules and regulations for the design of storm sewer and stormwater management systems.

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The Board discussed with Neil Tunison, County Engineer, the need for a traffic signal at State Route 48 and Foster Maineville Road in Maineville, Ohio.

Mr. Tunison stated he would be in touch with Ohio Department of Transportation to follow up on the traffic study, which was completed some time ago. Jerry Haddix, Grants Coordinator, was present along with representatives from the Village of South Lebanon and Bill Parrish, Pedcor Investments, to discuss the proposal to construct a 176unit apartment complex on 12 acres in the Village of South Lebanon with tax-credit funding from the State of Ohio. Mr. Haddix explained the proposed development and stated the need to "sign off" on the project stating that it is compliance with the Comprehensive Housing Improvement Strategy (CHIS). Commissioner Kilburn stated his opposition to the project being constructed in the proposed location Commissioner Kilburn exited the meeting at 11:56 a.m. Bill Parrish explained the income guidelines and stated his opinion that this project complied with the CHIS. Upon discussion, the Board recessed in order to have lunch and view the property. The Board reconvened at 1:30 p.m. with Mr. Kilburn being present. Upon discussion and upon viewing the proposed site, the Board authorized Robert D. Price, County Administrator, to sign letter of compliance with the CHIS. Upon motion the meeting was adjourned. C.
