DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, executive session was entered into at 4:09 p.m. to discuss personnel matters pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G) (1) and exited at 5:28 p.m.

Randy Andrews, adjacent property owner to the Snider Road water tower, was present to request the Board to approve payment for reimbursement of expenses associated with the water damage he receive to his property on September 2, 2003.

Mr. Andrews stated that his property had never flooded prior to the placement of rip rap by the contractor constructing the water tower adjacent to his property.

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Jack Flaherty, Mr. Andrews' insurance agent, stated that the Andrews been his customers for 23 years and had never had a water damage claim, even during the 9 inch rain during 1991. He then stated that their insurance would not cover the damages.

Commissioner Kilburn stated his desire to pay the claim and have Warren County go back on the contractor for reimbursement.

Upon further discussion, the Board directed the Water and Sewer Department to process payment of the voucher.

Gary Bock, Calloway Farms resident in Turtlecreek Township, was present to discuss complaints relative to a barn being constructed within his residential subdivision as well as inadequate/defective drainage ditches and culverts within the subdivision.

There was discussion relative to the covenants and restrictions which regulate the construction of outbuildings and upon discussion, the Board directed the Building and Zoning staff to contact Design Homes and Development for clarification on wording/approval of this particular outbuilding.

Upon further discussion, the Board directed staff to schedule a work session with the County Engineer to discuss the drainage concerns within the subdivision.

The Board discussed the proposed Ohio Public Works Commission (Issue 2) project on McClure Road in Turtlecreek Township.

Commissioner Kilburn stated his opinion that the project it not worthy of spending over \$600,000 in taxpayer's money.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #03-1468) to approve the Issue 2 contract for McClure Road in Turtlecreek Township with Mr. Kilburn voting nay.
