Mrs. South stated she is willing to put money into the roadways to improve traffic flow to Warren County residents. She stated she was not willing to commit to the amount of money she is willing to put into the project as she has not seen any figures related to their request. She then stated her opinion that State Route 122/I-75 Corridor should be commercial/Industrial zoned rather than residential.
