Mr. Lawson stated his opinion that this is a very poor site for an elementary school and stated his concerns. Kimra Sullivan, future resident of Clearcreek Township, stated that NCR deeded the current Kesling Park to Warren County in the 1970's for the purposes of a park, not a school. Dr. Robert T. Rhodes, Clearcreek Township resident, also spoke in opposition of the school being located on existing parkland. Upon motion the meeting was adjourned. C.
