DISCUSSIONS		

Donald Scholl, 8051 Actermann Road in Harlan Township, was present along with neighbors and the developer, Neil Strawser, to discuss concerns relative to the proposed Misty Meadows subdivision in Harlan Township.

Mr. Scholl stated his concerns relative to drainage problems and poor road conditions, which will be increased if the twenty-two lot subdivision is approved.

There was much discussion relative to what legal authority the Board of Commissioners have relative to approval of a final plat. It was determined that Bruce McGary, Chief Assistant Prosecutor, will prepare a legal opinion relative to the acceptant of roadways and the approval of final plats by the Board of Commissioners.

Neil Strawser stated that he has already invested thousands of dollars into this property development and that the development meets all the acreage requirements of the Board of Commissioners. He stated that he understands the desire to control growth but stated his feeling that the growth needs to be controlled in the beginning, not when after he has spent a tremendous amount of money for the project to go forward.

Kim Burke, adjacent property owner, questioned how the residents in the area would be notified of the outcome of the Prosecutor's recommendation.

The Board informed the residents that once a legal opinion is received, they will be notified to attend a work session.

Diane Roessner, Keever Road resident, was present to request the Board to include her in any economic development discussions or work groups.

Mrs. Roessner stated her concern that Warren County is not adequately planning for economic development.

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Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
