DISCUSSIONS

Bobby Jay, Union Road, Franklin Township resident, was present with complaints about the following matters:

- 1. Garbage cans being left in the driveway of his neighbor for weeks at a time—the Board suggested that he request the Township Trustees to write a letter to the offenders requesting them to bring in their trash cans.
- 2. He stated that a single homeowner purchased a lot adjacent to his daughter's property for \$80,000 and is now selling it to Adam Cristo for an entrance into a new subdivision surrounding the proposed relocated Middletown Regional Hospital.
- 3. Stated concerns with road conditions in the Hunter Sewer area.

Barry Sullivan, Zoning Department, was present for the site plan review application of Camp Kern in Turtlecreek Township.

Mr. Sullivan explained the request of Camp Kern to construct an assembly hall and cabin on their 420 acre camp site. He then reviewed the comments from all departments and officials concerned and stated his recommendation to approve the site plan review application.

Richard Naish, adjacent property owner, questioned what the future plans of the camp are. He questioned if they are trying to grow the camp to accommodate more children.

He stated that the current plans are just to construct the buildings to accommodate the population that already exists.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #04-1241) to approve the site plan review application.

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Pat Arnold South, President

Barry Sullivan, Zoning Department, was present for the site plan review application of Camp Joy in Washington Township. Mr. Sullivan explained the request to construct an assembly hall and a five-car garage on the 317.8 acre camp. He then stated his recommendation to approve the site plan review application. Mr. William Kasemeyer, adjacent property owner, stated his concern with the lights from the garage as well as the noise from the exhaust fans proposed. Representatives from Camp Joy stated that the fans are quiet and that the lights will not shine towards the Kasemeyer property. Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #03-1243) to approve the site plan review application. Dr. Colon, Hamilton Township resident, was present to request the Board for clarification of the issues surrounding the alleged sewering of the Mounts Road area of Hamilton Township. He stated that the Sanitary Engineer has produced various maps at various times and there is some confusion as to whether the area was sewered in the 1970's by a previous Board or whether the action taken by this Board in 2000 unintentionally sewered the area. Dr. Colon then requested the Board to direct staff to perform a study to be done to provide a time line of the events, the published official maps and official acts pertaining to the disputed situation. The Board stated they will direct staff to begin research on their request. Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
