DISCUSSIONS

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present along with Kurt Weber, Chief Deputy Engineer and Greg Horwadel, Deerfield Township Administrator, to discuss the final plan of Freedom Farm Subdivision in Deerfield Township.

Mrs. South questioned how and why they are showing a proposed roadway on the final plan that would give the developer road frontage onto a new road however, there is no roadway dedication being required.

Mr. Tunison stated that the proposed road is on the Warren County Thoroughfare Plan for the purpose of off-setting a dangerous intersection.

It was discovered that the property in question is zoned as residential, not commercial, and therefore, any road dedication would have to come with compensation due to the road improvement having no increase in value if the property remains residential.

Mr. Horwadel stated that if and when a rezoning application is submitted to the Township, a condition of approval of the rezoning would be that dedication and/or construction of a portion of the roadway be required.

Commissioner Kilburn stated his desire to not sign the final plat due to not having explicit language saying that the future dedication of the right of way shall be at no cost to the County.

Mr. McGary stated his opinion that it is not necessary for the Board to sign this final plat due to no road right of way being dedicated.

Mrs. South directed staff to place a note of the plan that the property owner can record the final plan without Board signature due to no right of way dedication.

Commissioner South updated Commissioner Kilburn on a discussion she had with Bruce McGary, Chief Deputy Prosecutor, directing Mr. McGary to draft language and procedures to begin process of amending the sewer improvement area in Hamilton Township to be the same as the Hamilton Township Land Use Plan Urban Service Area.

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Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
