PUBLIC HEARING

REZONING APPLICATION OF STEPHANIE BLACK, AGENT TO REZONE 3.28 ACRES IN HARLAN TOWNSHIP FROM GENERAL BUSINESS "B-2" TO RURAL RESIDENCE "R-1"

The public hearing to consider the rezoning application of Stephanie Black, agent to rezone 3.28 acres in Harlan Township from General Business "B-2" to Rural Residence "R-1" was convened this 12th day of April 2005, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Robert Craig, Regional Planning Commission, reviewed the location of the property and the surrounding zoning. He stated that a similar rezoning was approved in 2001 across the street from this property. He then stated that the Land Use Committee from Harlan Township has reviewed this area and confirmed the recommendation for this area to be zone residential. He then presented the Regional Planning Commission Executive Committee's recommendation to approve the rezoning application.

Mike Yetter, Zoning Inspector, stated that the Rural Zoning Commission voted unanimously to approve the rezoning application.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #05-486) to approve the rezoning application.

Jerry Spurling, Chief Building Official, was present to discuss the possibility of a "call ahead" inspection procedure being implemented at the request of the Board. Mr. Spurling stated that he would implement the process on a trial basis and evaluate if this will interfere with productivity of inspections.
On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session to discuss personnel matters at 11:31 a.m. pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G) (1) and exited at 12:10 p.m.
Bruce Smith, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), was present to discuss the Little Miami River.
Mr. Smith gave background information on preliminary approval to allow a doubling of the capacity of the Lower Little Miami Wastewater Treatment Plant. He discussed the quality of the Little Miami River relative to the Ohio EPA standards and stated that, in the future, the wastewater treatment plant will be request to treat effluent at a higher standard in order to be permitted to discharge into the river.
Jim Simpson, Ohio EPA, stated that a biology study was completed in 1998 which identified problems within the river.
Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
