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#### PUBLIC HEARING

### INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT REVENUE BOND FOR HIGH CONCRETE TECHNOLOGY IN THE CITY OF SPRINGBORO

Kimm Coyner, Economic Development Director, was present along with Ian Koeffler, Peck Shaffer & Williams, to explain the request for industrial development revenue bonds by High Concrete Technology in the City of Springboro.

Mr. Koeffler stated the purpose of the bonds and stated that the company employs approximately 130 people. He then explained how the process works and that Warren County would have no financial obligations by issuing said bonds.

Jamie Schultz, Manager of High Concrete Technology, stated that this is basically a refinancing of existing debt.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #05-1142) to authorize the issuance of industrial development revenue bonds for High Concrete Technology in the City of Springboro.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session to discuss personnel matters at 11:34 a.m. pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and exited at 12:02 p.m.

Jim Smith, Mayor of South Lebanon, was present to discuss the Village's request for the County to permanently provide water service to the Cedars of River's Bend apartment complex.

MINUTES AUGUST 9, 2005 PAGE 6 Commissioner South stated her request for the Village to provide sanitary sewer service to the Highland Park Subdivision without annexation and at the same rate as Village residents in exchange for the County doing the same with water service for the Cedars.

The Board requested Richard Renneker, Sanitary Engineer, to complete a sanitary sewer survey within Highland Park Subdivision to evaluate if the need and desire for sanitary sewer exists at the present time.

Upon further discussion, the Board agreed to sell South Lebanon bulk water for the apartment complex at the same rate as Warren County changes all existing customers. Mayor Smith agreed to prove sanitary sewer services to the residents within Highland Park Subdivision at the same rate as all the Village's existing customers.

Richard Renneker, Sanitary Engineer, was present along with Dave Walling, Assistant Sanitary Engineer, and Carl Gatton, Chief of Operations, for interviews with the top three engineering companies who submitted qualifications for the expansion of the Lower Little Miami Waste Water Treatment Plant.

Representatives from the following three engineering firms were interviewed:

Upon discussion, the Board determined to make a decision at a later date.
