Larry Brigham, Hamilton Township resident, gave an update on the Hamilton Township Land Use Plan Committee.

Mr. Brigham stated that Mark Hildebrant, Committee member, made a motion to extend the urban service area of Hamilton Township all the way to Morrow Cozaddale Road from the existing boundary of Zoar Road. He then stated that the Committee denied the motion.

Rick Inskeep, Butler Warren Road Resident in the City of Mason, discussed his concern over the future road widening of Butler Warren Road which would involve the taking of road right of way from front yards through eminent domain.

The Board stated their desire to schedule a work session with Neil Tunison, County Engineer relative to potential land takings.

The Board discussed the request of Dr. Uptegrove, Deputy Coroner, to attend a medical conference in Los Angeles, California.

The Board stated their concern for travel outside the approve 250 mile radius and denied the request.

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On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 11:00 a.m. to discuss personnel matters pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and exited at 11:20 a.m.

Commissioner Kilburn exited the meeting at 11:12 a.m.
