DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, executive session was entered into at 5:10 p.m. to discuss personnel matters pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and pending litigation pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(3) and exited at 6:28 p.m.

Deb Waters, Park Realty, was present along with Mrs. Rankin, property owners along Stephens Road in Hamilton Township to discuss erosion problems to her property being caused by the development of Regency Park Subdivision.

Chuck Petty, Engineer's Office, explained that the builder from one or two lots within Regency Park has deviated from the drainage plan and diverted water away from the detention pond.

The Board discussed their desire to send a letter to the builder and developer requesting them to correct the error.

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Commissioner South then requested a letter from Mr. Petty itemizing the problems.

Dave McElroy, Soil and Water Conservation District, stated he will create a remediation plan for Mrs. Rankin's property for the Board to request the building/developer to follow in order to repair the damages to her property.

Commissioner Kilburn stated his concern that this problem has been going on for two years and the Engineer's Office has taken no action to address the issue.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
