## PUBLIC HEARING #1 PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO POLICIES WITHIN THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT RELATIVE TO **ELECTRICAL REGISTRATIONS**

The first public hearing to consider proposed amendments to the policies within the Building Department relative to electrical registrations was convened this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2005.

Dave Gully, County Administrator, explained the purpose of amending policies is to the benefit of the property owners/customers. He stated that the proposed amendments would allow for

repairs to be completed by the utility providers.
Jerry Spurling, Chief Building Official, stated that, in the past, Cinergy has installed or repair the line and placed it on the ground for registered electricians to finalize installation. He state the safety issue of a live electrical line laying on the ground and stated this would eliminate to of the incidents.
Upon further discussion, the public hearing was closed.
Richard Renneker, Sanitary Engineer, was present to request the Board to approve water and sanitary sewer service to the remaining 18 acres of the Lewis property.
Mr. Renneker explained the location of the property and stated its location within the urban service area of the 2001 Hamilton Township Land Use Plan.
Upon discussion, the Board stated their approval for service.
Gary Browning and Dawn Johnson, Data Processing, were present to explain the contract wi

th SWOVA for GIS mapping services.

Ms. Johnson stated the intent to hire a full time employee for the everyday changes/programming needed but would utilize this company for the more intense programming needs.
