CONTINUATION OF THE PUBLIC TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF ACCESS MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS IN WARREN COUNTY

The continuation of the public hearing to consider the adoption of Access Management Regulations in Warren County was convened this 2nd day of February 2006, in the Commissioners Meeting Room.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, reviewed the changes as requested by the Board of Commissioners and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office.

Homer Hendrickson, Surveyor and Tax Map Department employee, questions when the application will be required.
