## **DISCUSSIONS**

Richard Renneker, Sanitary Engineer, was present along with Chris Brausch, Assistant Sanitary Engineer, to discuss a Ohio Public Works Commission Project Application being submitted by the Village of Maineville that, if approved will require water line relocation.

Mr. Renneker stated that if the County submits a joint application with the Village, if funded, the County will only be required to pay 16% of the cost.

Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #06-1013) to approve a joint Ohio Public Works Commission project application with the Village of Maineville.

PUBLIC HEARING #2 ADOPTION OF THE 2004 RESIDENTIAL CODE OF OHIO FOR ONE, TWO AND THREE FAMILY DWELLINGS

The second public hearing to consider the adoption of the 2004 Residential Code of Ohio for One, Two and Three Family Dwellings was convened this 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 2006, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Jerry Spurling, Chief Building Official, stated that this is required by the State of Ohio and there will now be consistency and quality control that is uniform throughout all of Ohio. He then stated the Homebuilders' Associations are in favor of the adoption.

There was discussion relative to an amendment which would allow the Board of County Commissioners to consider any appeals filed from decisions of the Building Department. The Board determined to amend that portion of the code.

Upon further discussion, the Board closed the public hearing and resolved (Resolution #06-1014) to adopt the 2004 Residential Code of Ohio for One, Two and Three Family Dwellings with the amendment to the section relative to the Appeals Board.

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Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
