PUBLIC HEARING

REZONING APPLICATION OF DR. WILLIAM LUKENS TO REZONE 1.234 ACRES IN TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP FROM HEAVY INDUSTRY "M-2" TO GENERAL BUSINESS "B-2"

The public hearing to consider the rezoning application of Dr. William Lukens, owner of record, to rezone 1.234 acres in Turtlecreek Township was convened this 19th day of December 2006, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Robert Craig, Regional Planning Commission, reviewed the location of the property, the surrounding zoning and stated the Regional Planning Commission Executive Committee's recommendation to approve the rezoning application.

Mike Yetter, Zoning Department, stated that the Rural Zoning Commission voted unanimously to approve the rezoning application.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #06-2166) to approve the rezoning application.

Mark Hildebrandt, Salt Run Ventures, was present to give an updated proposal relative to his desire to construct a residential subdivision along Foster Maineville Road in the Village of Maineville/Hamilton Township.

Mr. Hildebrandt stated his proposal to construct 160 lots (184 are allowed with 2.3 acres less commercial) spread throughout the entire acreage. He stated that the 1st phase would include 40 lots in 2008. The 2nd and later phases would be constructed in 2009-2011 after the sewer plant has been updated. He also stated his agreement to gift \$1500 to Little Miami Schools and \$250 to the Hamilton Township Park Board.

Mayor Marconet, Maineville, stated his approval of this subdivision in order to get a bigger base of income tax to take care of roads.

Commissioner Kilburn stated his opinion that housing is a loser and the need to stick to lower densities.

Curt Sellers, property owner, stated that with only 94 lots, it is not economically feasible to construct the project. He stated he does not like how everything is packed together with not enough green space. He stated his desire to build more homes on more land with commercial included in the proposal.

Commission Young questioned how the proposal went from 90 homes to 160 being proposed today.

There was discussion relative to pump station capacity.

Commission Young suggested the property owners consider the construction of office condominiums on the property and offered the help of Warren County Economic Development to find tenants. He stated office condominiums are more advantageous to the Village of Maineville as well as the schools.

CONTINUATION OF THE PUBLIC MEETING TO CONSIDER CONSENT DECREE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT RELATIVE TO J-II ENTERPRISES AND KENNETH AND BARBARA RICHARDSON LITIGATION

The continuation of the public meeting to consider the consent decree and settlement agreement relative to J-II Enterprises and Kenneth and Barbara Richardson pending litigation was reconvened this 19th day of December 2006, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Commissioner Kilburn reviewed the issues discusses at the last meeting relative to park dedication and the cleaning up of certain wording within the settlement agreement.

Patrick Merten, J-II Enterprises, stated that he has met with the Warren County Park Board and they intend to dedicate the open space to the Warren County Park Board. He then stated that the connector street parcel will be a dedicated lot and deeded to the Warren County Commissioners in the event the need to connect the property exists. He then stated that he does not have any concerns about the wording in the final documents. He stated that he would leave the final language to Bruce McGary, Chief Deputy Prosecutor, for approval.

There was discussion relative to the 25 foot conservation easement adjacent to Otterbein Home and the 50 acre park adjacent to all other residential land.

Mr. McGary presented an amended consent decree to the Board with the language struck that the Board had concerns with. He then presented an amended settlement agreement and read all changes in the record. He stated that after the Court hearing on December 28, 2006, he will come back to the Board to present a resolution for adoption along with final documents for signature.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board confirmed that they have complied with the statue to publish notice and all other Ohio Revised Code requirements relative to the consent decree and settlement agreement and stated their agreement to the proposed documents as amended.
