# PUBIC HEARING CONSIDER VACATION OF A PORTION OF FORDYCE ROAD IN WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP

The public hearing to consider the vacation of a portion of Fordyce Road in Washington Township was convened this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 2007, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

# CONSIDER ROAD NAME CHANGE OF A PORTION OF KING AVENUE TO KINGS COURT IN DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP
