Chief Deputy Larry Sims, Warren County Sheriff's Office, will review bids for a recommendation at a later date.

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On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

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Richard Renneker, Sanitary Engineer, was present for a work session and discussed the following matters:

- 1. Mark Leach, 7642 Brookfarm Court, is requesting a water adjustment due to the underground sprinkler system failure—The Board agreed to a 50% adjustment.
- 2. The utilization of the same easement area from the Warren County Park Board that Turtlecreek Township uses for a drainage swale—Mr. Renneker stated that the township desires the water and sewer department to fix the stormwater problems within the same bid process as the waterline project on Hoffman Drive. The Board stated the concern with justification of the cost associated with the project. The Board stated they do not mind including the project as an alternate to our bid but only if the Township pays for the work to be completed.
- 3. The Salt Run Ventures (Mark Hildebrandt) request for a letter stating sewer available to 90.8 acres along Foster Maineville Rd. in Hamilton Township. The Board stated their recollection that they stated approval for 96 residential taps as a maximum but requested staff to listen to the tape of the meeting where this was discussed. They also stated their desire to state a specific number of eru's in the letter.
- 4. Shops of Deerfield South—Mr. Renneker explained that the property owner paid for an 8" meter to the property and is being charged minimum billing for an 8" meter but in reality only installed five 1 ½" water lines. He requested the Board to consider adjusting the billing to reflect actual usage rather than minimum billing.
- 5. Otterbein Home Project on Bunnell Hill Road—Mr. Renneker stated that Otterbein Home is in the same situation as the Shops of Deerfield South. He stated that they need the larger water meter for fire protection but smaller service lines for daily water use.
