On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Mark Florence, Agent for the expedited type 2 annexation petition to annex 98.881 acres to the City of Lebanon, was present for the Board to consider the petition.

Mr. Florence stated that the petition includes two properties (Ullrich and Bailey) with 100% of signatures. He then stated that all matters required by law have been complied with.

Jim Vandergrift, Turtlecreek Township Trustee, stated that the township has no objection to the annexation.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #08-789) to approve the annexation petition.

Richard Renneker, Sanitary Engineer, was present along with staff to discuss the following matters:

- 1. Changing the policy relative to renters placing service in their name. There was much discussion relative to the continuance of the policy or requiring service to stay in the name of the property owner similar to the way some other jurisdiction require. The Board took the matter under advisement.
- 2. Water and Sewer Service to the Meijer Store Outlot and/or Mason-Montgomery Road and Irwin Simpson Rd. parcel—The Board authorize the County Administrator to sign a letter stating services are available.
- 3. Emergency interchange water agreement with Western Water—The Board agreed to the agreement.
- 4. Union Township Water Treatment Plant—The Board authorized the Water/Sewer staff to begin the process to sell the plant.

PUBLIC HEARING

REZONING APPLICATION OF FRED SEEGER TO REZONE 1.437 ACRES IN TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP FROM FLOOD ZONE "F" TO RURAL RESIDENCE "R-1"

The public hearing to consider the rezoning application of Fred Seeger, owner of record, to rezone 1.437 acres in Turtlecreek Township from Flood Zone "F" to Rural Residence "R-1" was convened this 20th day of May 2008, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Robert Ware, Regional Planning Commission, stated the RPC Executive Committee's recommendation to approve a modification to the application to only rezone the land located outside the 100- year flood plain, subject to the confirmation by the applicant's surveyor.

There was discussion relative to if the zoning on this property is changed, if it would take the property outside of the flood plain. It was determined that it would not remove the property from the flood plain and even if the zoning is changed from Flood Zone "F" to Rural Residence "R-1" the property owner would be required to comply with Flood Damage Regulations for anything proposed to be built within the 100 year flood plain.

Mike Yetter, Zoning Department, stated the recommendation of the Rural Zoning Commission to approve the application as submitted.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #08-790) to approve the rezoning application to rezone 1.437 acres in Turtlecreek Township from Flood Zone "F" to Rural Residence "R-1".
