PUBLIC HEARING

REZONING APPLICATION OF WOODWARD FARMS, LTD., INC. TO REZONE EIGHT ACRES IN TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP FROM RURAL RESIDENCE "R-1" TO RURAL RESIDENCE "R-1" AS A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT

The continuation of the public hearing to consider the rezoning application of Woodward Farms, Ltd., Inc. to rezone approximately 8 acres in Turtlecreek Township from Rural Residence "R-1" to Rural Residence "R-1" as a planned unit development was convened this 30th day of September 2008, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Commissioner South read a letter from the applicant requesting an additional continuance. She then explained the due process requirement that the Board is required to give. She stated that it is not unusual to be granted between 1 and 3 continuations.

Mike Killum, SR 741 resident, stated that the area property owners and law abiding citizens and stated that the applicant is not. He then questioned when the adjacent property owners will be given their due process.

Commissioner Young stated that, with his vote, this will be the last continuance approved.

Lee Hamilton, adjacent property owner, questioned if it was the law that the Board had to approve their request for a continuance.

Commissioner South stated that it is not the law but has been the custom of the Board in past instances.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #08-1467) to approve the continuation of the public hearing to October 23, 2008, at 5:30 p.m.
