DISCUSSIONS

Several students from Lebanon High School government class were present to shadow the County Commissioners and County Administrator for student government day.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Bruce McGary, Chief Deputy Prosecutor, was present along with Richard Renneker, Sanitary Engineer, and Chris Brausch, Deputy Sanitary Engineer, to discuss the easement acquisition process due to the recent change in the law.

Mr. McGary stated that when the legislature adopted policy outlining the use of eminent domain, they inadvertently changed the process in which the County must follow relative to acquisition of easement for water and sanitary sewer projects.

Mr. McGary stated that the Board has adopted a policy which exempts the process for easements which cost less than \$10,000 with the understanding that the W/S Department rarely acquires easements that are valued higher. He then stated that the Water and Sewer Department is in the beginning stages of constructing a waterline to accommodate Atrium Medical complex which requires the acquisition of easements along the front of commercial properties which are estimated to be valued at higher than \$10,000.

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Mr. McGary then gave the background history relative to the law change and stated his opinion that the law can be interpreted two different ways:

- 1. Appraisal only applies if the property will be appropriated through the court or
- 2. Appraisal is required every time, whether the easement is donated and/or under \$10,000

There was much discussion relative to the proposed policy the Board desire to develop.

Upon further discussion, the Board directed Chris Brausch, Deputy Sanitary Engineer, to develop a draft policy in conjunction with the Prosecutor's Office and present it to the Board at a later date.

Representatives from Hamilton Township were present along with the representatives from the County Engineer's Office to discuss the performance bond releases and acceptance of streets and sidewalks within Wedgwood Subdivision Sections Q, R, S, T and U in Hamilton Township.

Gary Boerhes, Hamilton Township, requested the County to hold the performance bonds as additional 2 or 3 years to ensure sidewalks are constructed properly due to past experiences with this developer.

Bruce McGary, Chief Deputy Prosecutor, stated that what Mr. Boerhes is suggesting is not a bad idea, however, we are under a contractual obligation with the developer and that does not allow us to extend the bonding any further than the agreement.

Donna Miller, property owner within the development, stated that she is not the original homeowner but her neighbor is. She stated that they are having many problems with sidewalks, driveways and garage floors as they are falling apart within the subdivision. She stated her feeling that the builder has a moral obligation to correct the problems.

Becky Ehling, Hamilton Township Trustee, questioned if the Board can do anything to strengthen the standards of installation of sidewalks.

There was discussion relative to amending the regulations relative to the requirement of compaction to a certain standard or the use of "flash fill" under the sidewalks.

The Board stated their desire to consider amendments to the construction standards relative to sidewalks.

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Upon further discussion, the Board approved the roadways within Wedgwood Subdivision, Sectiby Hamilton Township.	1
