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DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

The Board met this 15th day of January 2009, to continue the discussion relative to the Type 2 Expedited Annexation Petition of Richard Paolo, Agent, to annex 485.2347 to the Village of Maineville.

Mr. McGary stated that the attorney for Hamilton Township Trustees has filed a memorandum in opposition to the annexation petition and now the agent for petitioners has filed a memorandum is support of the petition for annexation. He then stated that he has researched the contiguous intent and the legislation. He then stated that upon his research, he has determined that the expedited annexation is procedural and the Board must follow the conditions which are outlined in the law.

Commissioner Kilburn stated his opinion that anytime the Board of Commissioners has to render a decision on a matter, he feels there is discretion on the matter. He then stated his opinion that there is a problem with contiguity as well as the multiple annexations that add up to more than the maximum 500 acres to be considered for the expedited process.

Mr. Kilburn then read an email from Gene Duvelius, Hamilton Township Trustee, and from Mr. Phelan, an adjacent property owner, in opposition to the annexation petition.

Mr. Paolo stated that the law is mandatory for approval if the check list in all in order. He stated that this petition for annexation is fully compliant with the law and should be approved.

Mr. Ritchey, Attorney for Hamilton Township, stated the Township's argument that the entire boundary of the annexation must be considered and therefore, the property to be annexed is not contiguous to the Village of Maineville.

Commissioner Young stated that his duties as a County Commissioner are as follows:

- 1. Follow the Law
- 2. Protect Property Owner Rights
- 3. Utilize Common Sense

Commissioner Young then stated that sanitary sewers and/or growth is not an issue in this annexation. He stated that the line in the sand has been drawn as far as sanitary sewer service

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and will not be moved. He then stated that the law clearly states that approval is an administrative action and this Board has no discretion.

Commissioner South stated her opinion that this Board has no discretion on this matter. She stated that the petition meets the 5% contiguity per the Map Room. She then stated that she does not like the configuration of this annexation.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #09-91) to approve the expedited type 2 annexation petition.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
