PUBLIC HEARING CONSIDER FEE INCREASES WITHIN THE BUILDING AND ZONING DEPARTMENT

The public hearing to consider proposed fee increases within the Building and Zoning Department was convened this 24th day of February 2009, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Jerry Spurling, Chief Building Official, reviewed the proposed increases and a comparison of our proposed fees versus surrounding municipalities and counties.

Commissioner Kilburn questioned if his staff level is where it needs to be relative to the amount of work required with the decrease in development?

Mr. Spurling replied affirmatively. He stated that the Board has laid off one employee and another is retiring and will not be replaced.

Betsy Kelly, Cincinnati Homebuilders Association, stated that the fee increases are in line with the need and that the Building and Zoning staff has done an outstanding job justifying the need for the increase. She then stated the following request:

1. Leave out the automatic index of fee increases every year.

Mr. Spurling stated that he has already taken that out of the proposed increase request.

Commissioner Kilburn questioned if the Board should maybe consider the increase for at least the next two years.

2. They would like the Board to delay implementation of the increase for one year.

Commissioner South stated that realizing that some of our increases still make us in the low range on the comparison chart, Warren County will still be in the middle of the fee range. She then stated she has a problem with any delayed implementation.

Upon further discussion, the Board closed the public hearing and adopted resolution #09-308 to approve fee increases with the Building and Zoning Department effective April 1, 2009.
